

## Getting to Wood Quay Venue

Wood Quay Venue is located in the heart of the city of Dublin, at the Dublin City Council Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8.

The Venue entrance is located at the east side of Council Offices, just off Essex Street West.



Car parking is not available at the site however the venue is fully accessible by public transport.

#### By bus:

- Essex Quay bus stop is served by 145, 37, 39, 39A, 51D, 69, 69X, 70, 79, 79A, 83 and 83A.
- Ormond House bus stop is served by the 69, 69Xm 79, 79A and 847.
- Inns Quay bus stop is served by the 25, 25A, 25B, 25D, 25X, 26, 37, 39, 39A, 51D, 51X, 66, 66A, 66B and 66X.
